Imperatives

Conjugation

The imperative form of a verb is used for giving commands. It is made up of three parts:

- 1. The prefix "-," (pronounced like "be" in "bed")
- 2. The present stem of the verb
- 3. The imperative suffix (plural only)

Here is an example for the verb "to sit":



If the first vowel of the present stem of the verb has an "o" sound, the prefix changes into "__," (pronounced like "bo" in "bold").

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بخور (singular) بخور
Kill them! (plural) بکشیدشان
برو (Go! (singular)
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Negative Imperatives

The negative imperative structure is exactly like the normal imperative, except that the suffix preceding the verb is ":" (pronounced like "na" in "narrow").

كشين Present Stem: نشستن Don't sit! (singular)

ننشينيد!

Exceptions

Don't sit! (plural)

The imperative form of the two verbs "بودن" ("to be") and "داشتن" ("to have") is not made using the general rule.

Present Stem: باش Be! (singular) باش Be! (plural) باشید

As you see, the only difference was that the prefix was omitted. The difference is more dramatic for the verb "داشتن" ("to have"):

دار :Present Stem داشتن :Present Stem داشته باش :Have! (singular) داشته باشید :Have! (plural)

Another group of exceptions is the class of combined verbs that their verb part is from the infinitive "مُدِن" ("to do") or "مُدن" ("to become"). (Actually, there are other verbs that go in this group as well, but there is no rule to distinguish them. They must be learned by experience.) For these verbs, like the verb "to be", the prefix "ب" is omitted. Here are some examples:

Work! You lazy people! کار کنید، تنبلها! First make sure (//t. become sure) that اول مطمئن شو که منم بعد در را باز کن. it's me (//t. I am me) then open the door.

For all these exceptional verbs, the negative imperative is obtained by simply adding the "prefix before them and omitting nothing.

Examples

Here is a set of examples containing instances of some different cases.

Know your enemies! دشمنانت را بشناس! عکس من را یکش. Draw my picture. اسمت را بگو. Say your name. به این تابلو دست نزن! Don't touch this painting! لطفاً در اینجا یارک نکنید. Please don't park here. Give me your hand. دستت را بده به من. اینقدر بدجنس نباش. Don't be so mean. هیچ کس را دوست نداشتهباش. Don't love anyone. به گذشته فکر نکن. Don't think about the past. اگر خوب کار نکرد اخراجش کن. If he\she didn't work well, fire him/her. این را خوب یاد بگیر، Learn this well.

About the last group of exceptions, it should be added that the verbs "گردن and "شدن must always be considered as part of a combined verb:

الله lit. become slim a bit! كمى لاغر شو! Make me president! من را رئيس جمهور كتيد!

They are only considered separate simple verbs when there is no noun in the sentence that could possibly be part of a combined verb. This is the only way they can come with the "-," suffix.

It is important to learn the imperative correctly since its structure is also used in conjugating verbs of the present subjunctive tense. The following table might be helpful for knowing where to use the "__" suffix in imperatives.

Verb	Imperative
بودن:	باش
:داشتن	داشته باش
Other simple verbs (e.g. "خنديدن):	Must use "بـ" (e.g. "بخند")
Combined verbs from "کردن" and "شدن":	("فکر کن" (e.g. "بو"
Other combined verbs:	Must use "ب" (e.g. "ياد بگير")
Prefixed verbs:	No general rule
