Past Perfect

Conjugation

The Persian past perfect is made up of two parts:

- 1. past participle of the verb
- 2. corresponding past simple tense form of the verb "to be"

Here is an example for the verb "to read":

خواند :Past Stem خواندن :Verb Infinitive

[I] had read	خوانده بودم
[you] had read	خوانده بودی
[he/she/it] had read	خوانده بود
[we] had read	خوانده بوديم
[you (pl.)] had read	خوانده بوديد
[they] had read	خوانده بودند
	[you] had read [he/she/it] had read [we] had read [you (pl.)] had read

Usage

Persian past perfect is almost exactly like English past perfect.

They had searched everywhere well. همه جا را خوب گشته بودند.

The enemy had blocked all the roads. الم بسته بود.

I had never seen his/her mother till that day. با الم روز هيچوقت مادرش را نديده بودم.

Twenty years had passed but Tehran had almost not changed at all. بیست سال گذشته بود اما تهران تقریباً هیچ فرقی نکرده بود

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
